

Requirements: (WSPTA Uniform Bylaws Article 5, Section 5A)

A local PTA or council nominating committee of three members shall be elected by ballot at least 30 days preceding the election of officers. If only three candidates are nominated, the three shall be declared elected. A plurality vote shall elect. If a vacancy on the nominating committee occurs, the board of directors of the local PTA or council may appoint a replacement.
